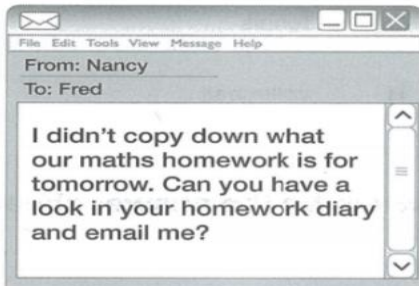

Over the last few years, the Museum of Science in Manchester has held an exhibition which invites visitors to do exactly that.
